Thailand International Camporee 2008

Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the National Scout Organization of Thailand , we would like to invite your National Scout Organization to participate in the Thailand International Camporee 2008 which will be held from 27 December 2008 – 1 January 2009 in Mon Come On Camp, Chiangmai, Thailand.

Basic information follows:

- Date:** 27 December 2008 – 1 January 2009. Participants are requested to arrive on 26th December 2008 and may leave the camp on 2 January 2009.
- Venue:** Mon Come On Camp, Chiangmai, Thailand
- Theme:** "Scouting Think Earth"
- Eligibility:** Scouts aged between 13 to 17 years old. Each Patrol should consist of ten Scouts and one Adult Leader.
International Service Team (IST) should be above 18 years old and above.
- Fee:** US\$ 100.00 per participant payable upon registration.
The fee covers accommodation, food, program of activities, Jamboree Kit, Insurance and Transportation.
- Transportation:** Transportation will be arranged from Chiangmai International airport, Chiangmai Railway Station, Chiangmai bus terminal to Campsite and During Pre or Post-Camporee activity.
- How to reach:** Please check direct flights to Chiangmai International Airport from your country or take an overnight Train or Bus to Chiangmai from Bangkok for about THB600.00 – 850.00
- Weather:** Temperature in December during day time will around 25°C – 30°C and 12°C – 17°C during night time.

Equipment: Participants should bring personal camping equipment, including sleeping bag, cutlery, flashlight, rain gear. Tents will be provided during the Jamboree.

Pre- Post Camporee Activity: USD50.00 per day/per participant for Pre or Post camporee activity. It includes moderate accommodation in a hotel in the city, city tour and local/traditional dinner.

Programme Highlights : A wide variety of activities will be offered, both on-site and off-site. Such activities as ; Camp Life Activity, Pioneering, Challenge Valley, Overnight & Survival Hiking, Night Compassing, Craft & Cultural, Friendship Games, New Year Party and making new friends with Scouts from many countries.

Date : 27 December 2008 – 1 January 2009, Participants are request to arrive on 26 Dec 07 and may leave on 2 Jan 09 included Post- Camporee activity (Chiangmai city tour one night stay in the city)



Venue : Mon come on Camp, Chiangmai, Thailand



Transportation : Transportation will be arranged from Chiangmai International airport, Chiangmai Railway Station, Chiangmai bus terminal to Campsite and During Pre or Post-Camporee activity.



How to reach : You can have direct flights to Chiangmai International Airport from your country.
From Bangkok you can also take Overnight Train or Bus to Chiangmai



Eligibility : Scouts between 13 – 17 years old and registered through National Scout Organization.
Each patrol of 10 should be accompanied by a Leader.
International Service Teams should be rover or scout leader.



Fee : 100.00 USD per participant all Scouts, Leaders and IST payable in cash upon registration. The fee covers accommodation, food, program activities, Jamboree Kit, Insurance and Transportation.



50.00 USD per participant for Post camporee activity that include Hotel, a night stay in the city, city tour and local traditional dinner.

Climate : The temperature ranges between 25 – 30 C During the day
The temperature ranges between 12 – 17 C at night
